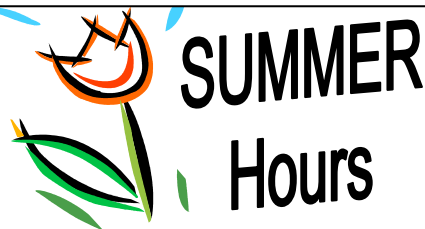

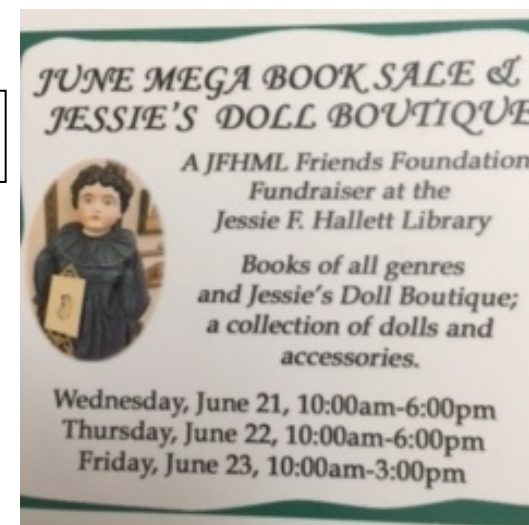

June is a month of milestones. Ernest W. Hallett, born in 1882, would be celebrating his 135th birthday on Saturday, June 11.

During 2017, the JFHML will be celebrating 39 years of service on the Cuyuna Range. When Mr. Hallett built this Library back in 1978 as a living memorial to his wife and partner, Jessie Fern, might he have envisioned the multigenerational community hub which he created, staying vibrant for decades? We think the Hallett's would be pleased with the manner in which the Library has remained steadfast and true to their mission--- providing state-of-the art technology, programming for all ages, and maintaining a building which creates an environment for life-long learning and a place to connect with others. We are proud to continue this heritage of generosity and community enhancement.
