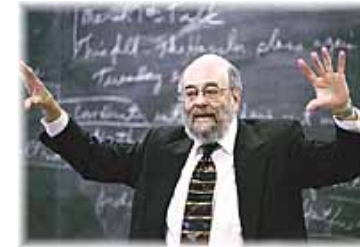
Join the Green Initiative!
